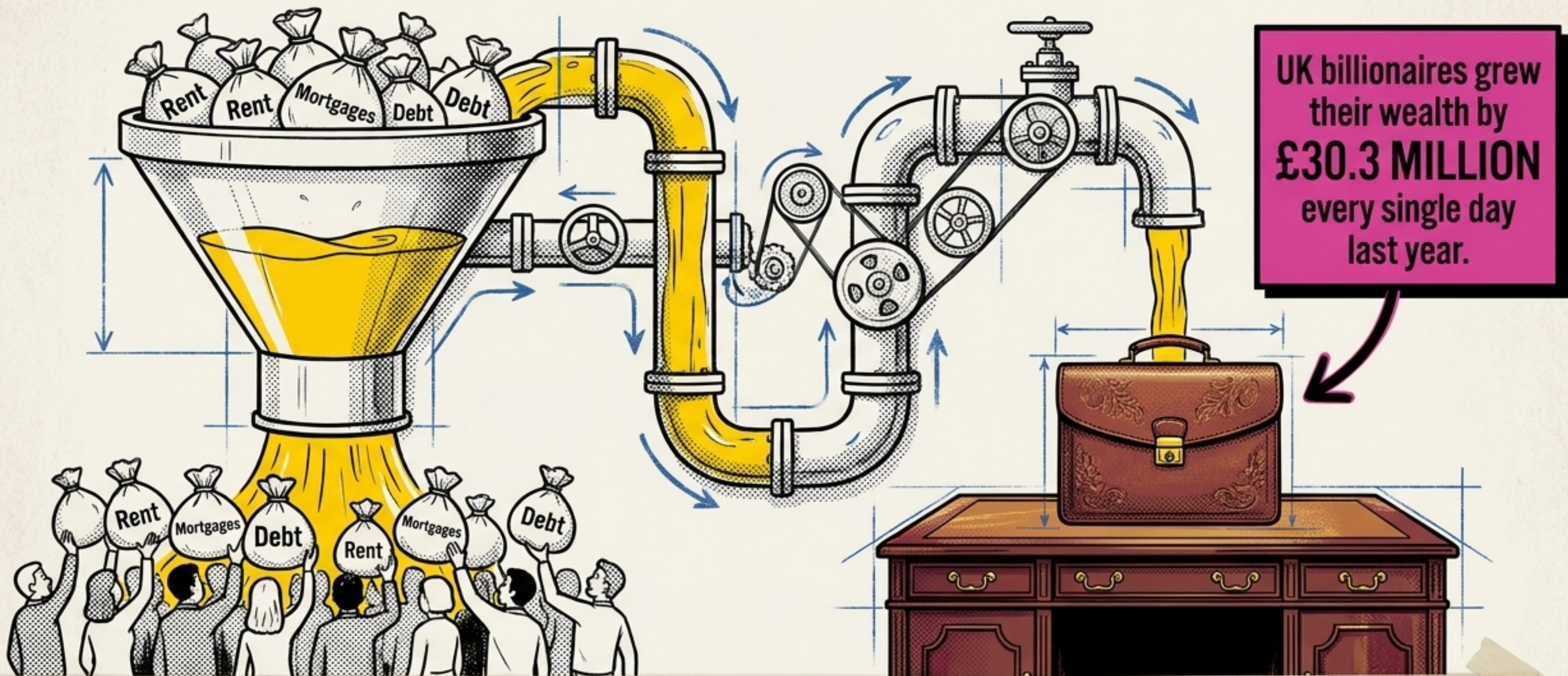

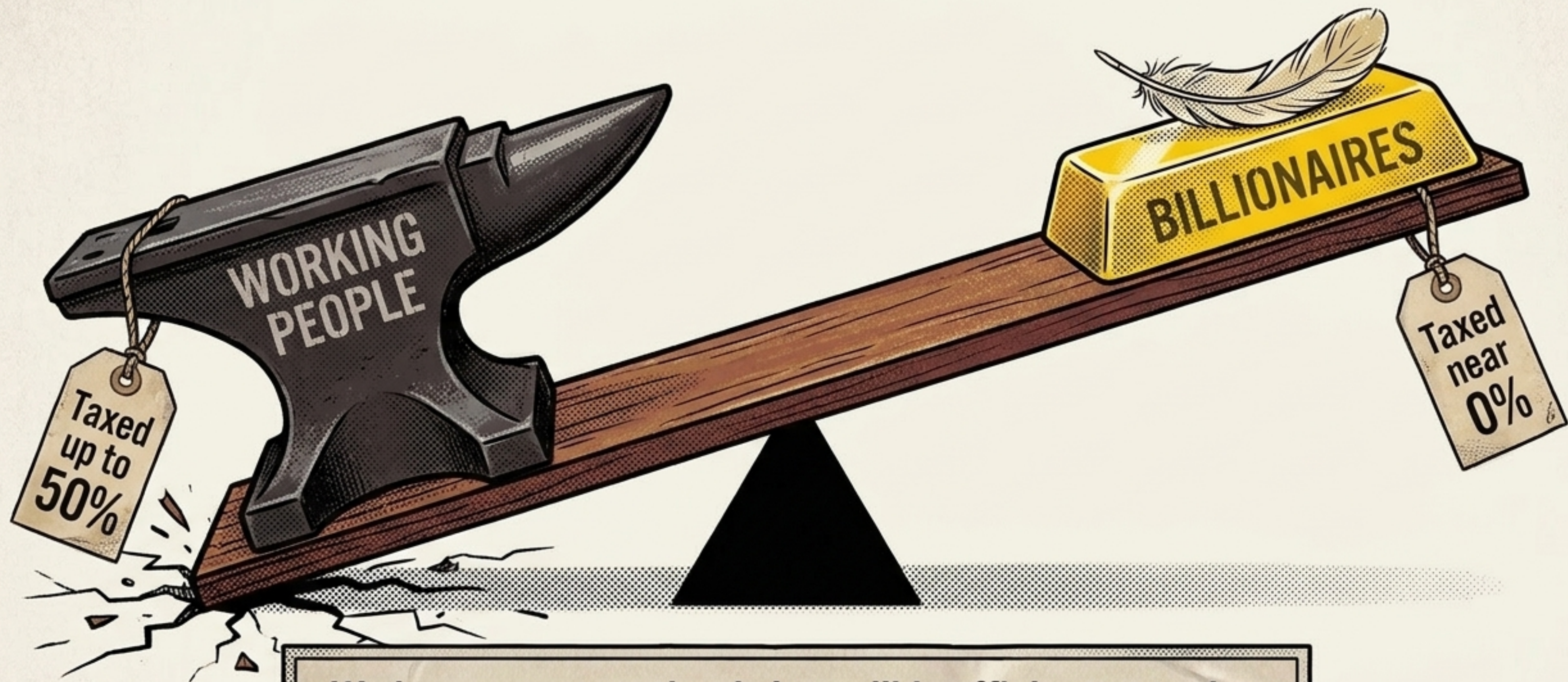

Player 1 vs. Player 2

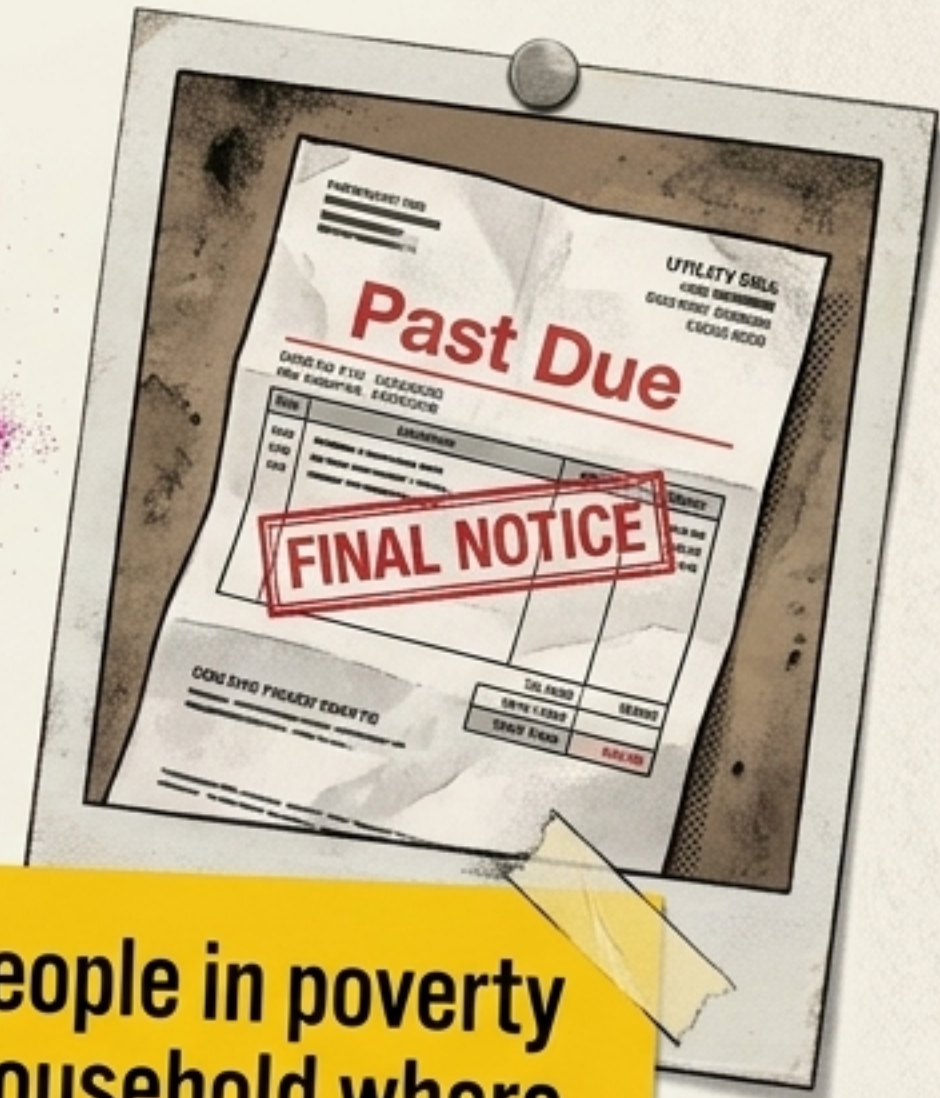

The true cost of a rigged game

4 MILLION

Kids currently living in poverty in the UK (27%).



60% of people in poverty live in a household where someone WORKS.

The hard work pays off rule is fundamentally broken. Poverty is now an engineered feature of the economy, not a bug.

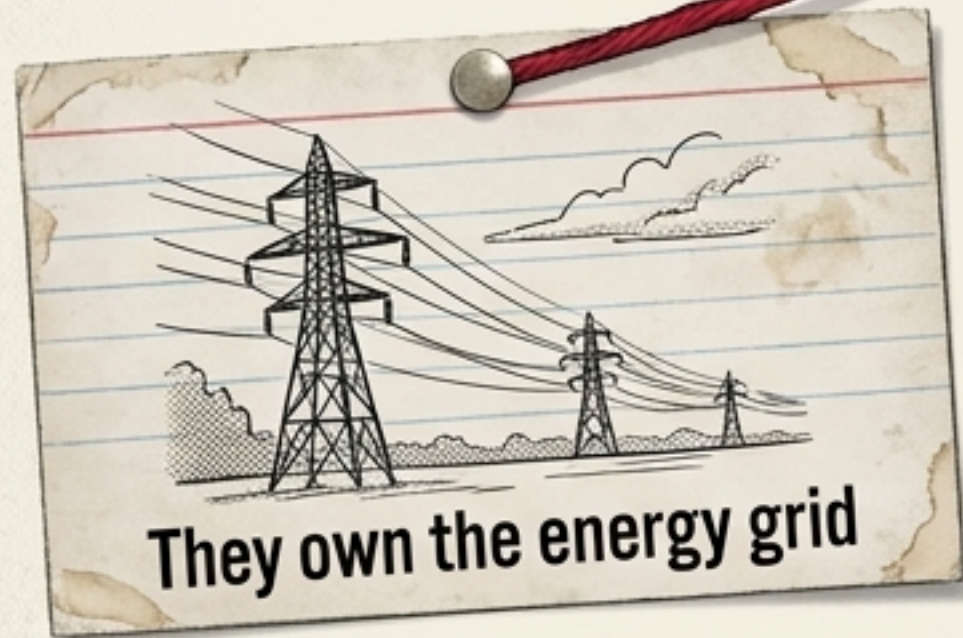
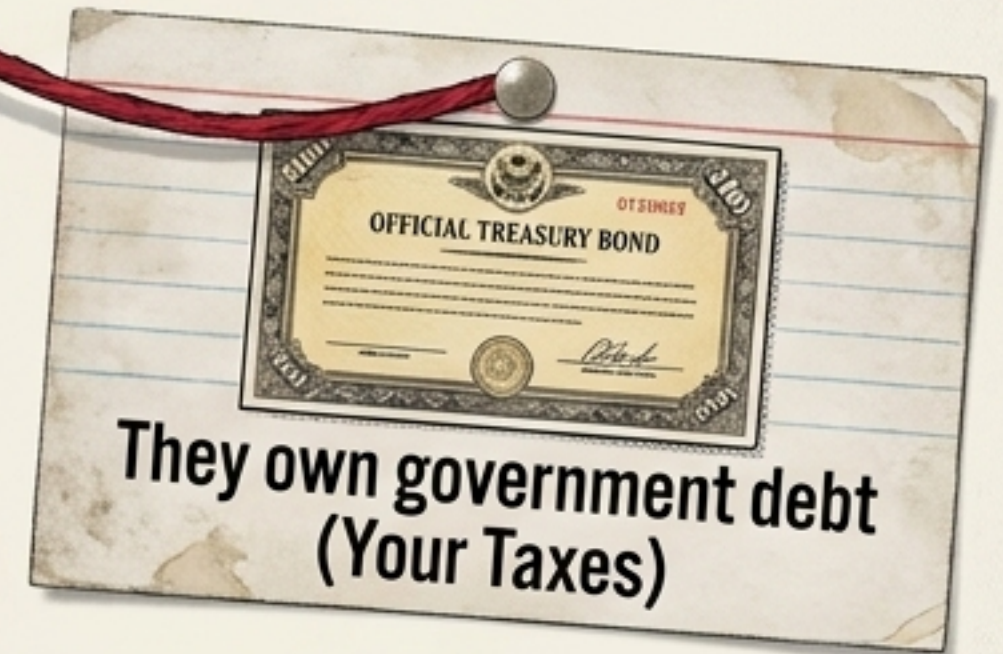
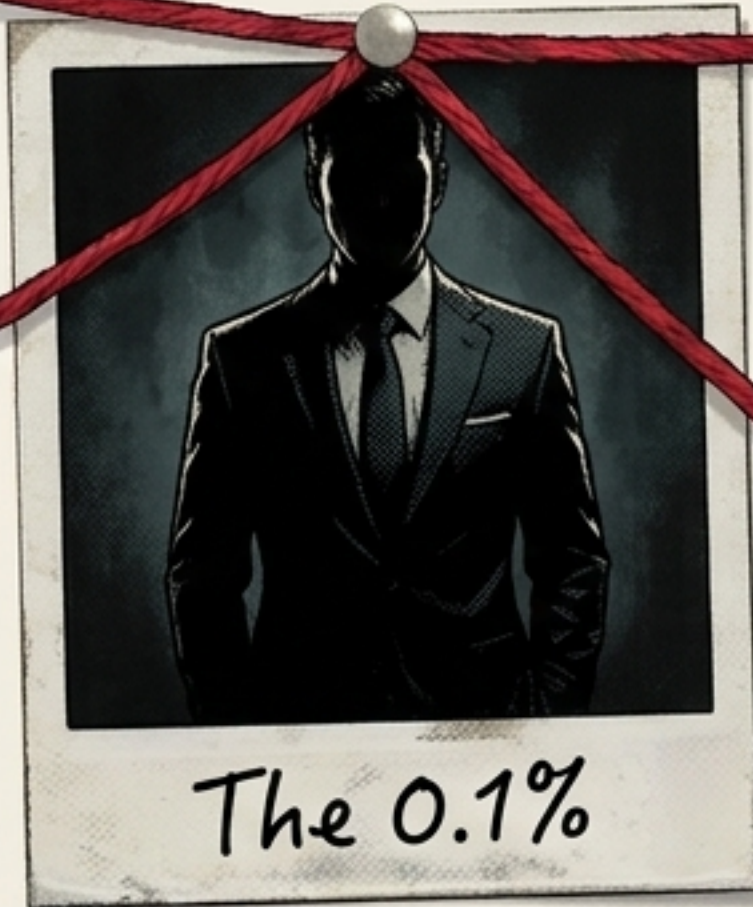

1. Millionaires rarely move. In Scandinavia's wealth tax reforms, only 0.01% of the richest households relocated.

The Ultimate Patch: The Wealth Tax

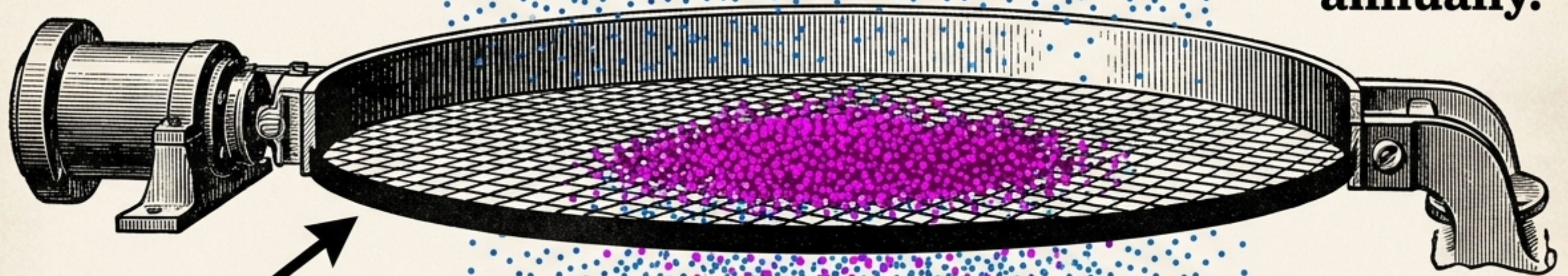
The Mechanics

A 2% annual tax strictly on assets over £10 million.

The Impact

Shields 99.96% of the population completely. Catches only the 20,000 ultra-wealthy individuals at the very top.

The 10-Point Combo for a Fair Economy

**Upgrade 1:
Equalize Capital Gains**



Tax passive wealth (selling stocks/property) at the exact same rate as active labor (your income tax).

Unlocks: £12-14 Billion

**Upgrade 2:
Close Non-Dom Loopholes**



Stop wealthy residents from shielding offshore wealth from domestic taxation.

Unlocks: £1 Billion

**Upgrade 3:
Apply National Insurance
to Investment Income**



Make those living off dividends contribute to the safety net just like wage-earners.

Unlocks: £10.2 Billion

Proposals backed by Tax Justice UK to raise a total of £60 Billion annually.

How to take the controller back

Step 1: Rewire the Narrative.

Stop blaming the poor for systemic failure. Share the data. Tell your network that 60% of poverty is in working homes.



Membership Card

Step 2: Join the Guild.

You cannot fight capital alone. Support advocacy groups doing the math: Tax Justice UK, Patriotic Millionaires, and The Poverty Alliance.



Step 3: Pressure the Devs

Demand explicit commitments from politicians. Do not accept the excuse that there is no money. Demand a wealth tax.



70 years ago, our grandparents fought to build a middle class out of extreme inequality. They didn't beg for it. They took it by taxing the rich.
